



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FUNDRAISING NEED SOME HELP OR ADVICE?

Putting on a fundraising event can be stressful, especially on top of your usual university workload. We hope that we can make your life a little bit easier with some help for selecting venues and some guidelines on how best to organise and run your event.

There are a number of venues in town. We would like to draw you towards three with whom we are able to help facilitate events and provide advice as to what could work best.

The Four Horsemen – Bournemouth Triangle – 60 Capacity

The Four Horsemen is a 60 capacity basement microclub. Think along the lines of the boiler-room shows, this space is for those who would like to create a house party vibe.

Aimed at providing a space for people who want to run events with less stress, the smaller capacity makes creating a sellout event easier and removes the need to hard sell hundreds of tickets.

The venue is multipurpose and can be utilised for meetings, socials, quiz nights, screenings or anything else you can imagine. Curfew is 2am.

- Venue hire is free
- First refusal on all including weekend dates for AUB students

Bomo Bunker – Lansdown, 200 Capacity Nightclub - £70 Hire

A staple in the local scene. The Bomo Bunker is the ideal location for the larger event. With a late licence they host a number of events from local promoters on the weekend as well as a lot of student fundraisers. The venue is available weekday nights for fundraisers. Opening hours are from 10pm - 3am, the venue is fully staffed and equipped.

- Venue Hire is £70
- Weekday Dates Only

Buffalo Bar – Lansdown – 160 Capacity Live Music Venue - £90 Hire

Buffalo Bar in the Lansdown is located above the Bomo Bunker. It has become a creative space and hosts many live band nights. If your event requires more space than The four horsemen and you are considering live music, Buffalo might be the place for you. Tuesdays are not bookable, but other days are open for negotiation.

You can not charge entry on the door here, however there are options for either a % of the bar income, which can work out quite well if you expect a high attendance of people drinking, or a suggested door donation. A £90 fee will cover you for a sound engineer and sound desk. There is a late 4am curfew and an overall capacity of 160 for live shows.

- Any Date is available but do make contact more than one month in advance
