



Our Sports Assistant, Joss will be able to tell you all about Give it a Go, as well as sports and competitions at AUB.

Where can I get tickets?

All official AUBSU tickets will be sold online via our website shop: aubsu.co.uk/tickets

How do I join a club, society or network?

Our website has a long list of clubs, societies and networks that students run throughout the year. You can join at any time by contacting them directly and signing up for membership.

What do I do if an event is sold out?

Some of our events, such as workshops, have a limited number of spaces. This is because these events are pre-booked with an external organiser or have a limited amount of materials available.

If we have any spare tickets, we will make an announcement on social media. We may have some no-show spaces available, so if you're super-keen, contact us at the start of the event to double-check.

What if I can no longer attend an event?

If you can't attend an event for which you have bought a ticket, please let us know. This means we can reallocate your ticket to someone else.

Tickets are non-refundable, however if you are unsure of anything, please do read our Refund Policy. It is up to you to make sure you can attend an event to the best of your ability before you purchase a ticket.

How do I buy tickets?

Our website people haven't yet been able to confirm all of your student IDs with the university Boring IT stuff means that for the time being, you'll have to create a guest account on our website to purchase freshers' tickets. To do this, click on 'log in' on the top right-hand corner of our website, then 'guest login', then 'register new account' and 'new student'. Easy peasy.
